GROSSER PREIS VON DEUTSCHLAND (GERMAN GRAND PRIX) 2010 / Group I

Purse: at least €150,000 (70,000 – 35,000 – 18,000 – 10,000 – 7,000 – 5 x 2,000)

Course: 2000 m – auto start – for four-year-old horses from all countries (born in 2006)

If more than 17 horses are announced as starters, two or more heats will take place. Purse for each: 10,000 euros (4500 – 2500 – 1500 – 900 – 600). Ten horses are entitled to start the final. If there are two heats, the five best-placed horses in each will qualify; if there are three heats, the three best-placed horses in each and the fastest fourth-placed horse will qualify. To determine which horse is the fastest, finishing times are compared to the nearest hundredth of a second. In the event of identical finishing times or a tie, lots shall be drawn to decide which horse is granted the last remaining place in the final. If more heats take place, this method is applied analogously.

A nomination for the German Grand Prix 2010 is also valid for the preliminary races held in Gelsenkirchen for domestically bred horses in 2010.

Conditions:

June 2010:

No more than 5,000 euros – 2000 m – auto start – purse 5,000 euros

July 2010:

No more than 10,000 euros – 2000 m – auto start – purse 7,500 euros

August 2010:

25 m handicap for 25,001 euros and over – 2025 m – tape start – purse 10,000 euros

September 2010:

No more than 15,000 euros – 2000 m – auto start – purse 7,500 euros

The detailed call for entries will be published in 2010. No additional entrance fees shall be charged.

The event organiser will hold a "**Grossen Stuten-Preis von Deutschland**" (**German Filly Grand Prix**) with a purse of at least €10,000 (and no more than €30,000) from the excess entrance fee payments (as per § 43 para. 9 TRO) if at least nine fillies are announced as starters and at least nine horses start the main race. For the participants, the last entrance fee payment shall be waived.

In addition, the event organiser reserves the right to hold one or more ancillary races, with a purse of at least €5,000 (and no more than €15,000) from the excess entrance fee payments (as per § 43 para. 9 TRO). This requires at least nine starters in each instance. For horses not participating in the main race, the last entrance fee payment shall be waived. If ancillary races are not held, or if additional money from excess entrance fee payments is available, this will be added to the purse for the main race.

At least 250 nominations are required.

Entrance fee: €2,250 plus VAT, comprising the following:

Nomination deadline: extended to Monday, 16 February 2009

Late nomination:

A late nomination is possible on **15/02/2010** or on the **day of the announcement of starters**.

For late nomination of a horse on 15/02/2010, twice the entrance fee payments due up to that date (€1,140) plus prepayment of entrance fee payments 8 to 10 (€730) must be paid, i.e. a total sum of €1,870 plus VAT. If the horse is registered as a starter, the 11th payment also falls due.

For late nomination of a horse on the day of the announcement of starters, a sum of 18,000 euros plus VAT (11th payment included) must be paid.

Announcement of starters: Friday, 8 October 2010, by 11:00 am
